



Blackout Rules

The Blackout period includes:

~ the first 30 days at Daughter's House

~ in the event you do not have a job after the standard 30-day blackout period Blackout will be extended until you find employment.

~ blackout applies to anyone that becomes unemployed for any reason until new employment starts.

You must have a job and be in "good standing" with the house to be off blackout. Examples of "not being in "good standing" include but are not limited to the following: verbal warning, fines, rent delinquencies, conflict or matter under review.

BLACKOUT RULES:

No outings except for meetings, work or looking for employment, rides and outings are to be with house mates or those on the approved list only.

No Car (if unemployed)

No Phone (if unemployed)

No overnight passes will be approved during Blackout.

Guest Passes will be reviewed for consideration based on the circumstance i.e. holiday, etc.

*During Blackout:

- Cars and Phones **are permitted** for those who are employed all other black out rules apply.

Curfew: after work or meeting no exceptions

BLACKOUT SCHEDULE:

Monday-Friday ~ Up by 9am and out of room from 10am – 2pm

Saturday and Sunday / Days off (House Rules apply).
